

## **HISTORY**

Early 1930s	Dr. Karl Boehmert opens patent law practice in Berlin.
1945	Relocation of law practice from Berlin to Bremen.
1950s	Albert Boehmert joins practice as patent attorney.
1950 until 1972	Growth of BOEHMERT & BOEHMERT as nationally and internationally renowned address for intellectual property protection matters. Key areas of expertise: patent and trademark law.
1972	Practice becomes mixed law firm comprising patent attorneys and attorneys at law.
1977	Founding of FORRESTER & BOEHMERT in Munich as European law firm, to work solely with European patent matters before the European Patent Office.
1978	European Patent Office opens.
1990	Merger of BOEHMERT & BOEHMERT with the law practice of Professor Wilhelm Nordemann (founded 1945) in Berlin, which is specialised in copyright and competition law.
To present	Growth of firm to comprise 11 offices (8 German, 3 international). BOEHMERT & BOEHMERT today enjoys an exceptional standing amongst German law firms across the whole field of intellectual property.
