2. Purpose of processing:

The photos/videos are used for the purpose of internal and external company presentation and communication.

3. Legal basis of the processing:

We collect, store, process, and use your photos/videos based on Art. 6 para. 1 lit. a GDPR (consent) only if you have given your consent.

4. Right to Withdraw Consent:

You have the right to withdraw your consent at any time with effect for the future. The legality of the processing carried out based on the consent up to the withdrawal remains unaffected by the withdrawal. The withdrawal can be directed to: datenschutzbeauftragter@boehmert.de.

5. Categories of Recipients of Personal Data:

Your photos/videos are processed internally by the responsible departments for the above-mentioned purposes. Commissioned service providers may also process your personal data within the framework of our order according to Art. 28 GDPR. When publishing photos/videos on social media channels, it cannot be ruled out that your data will also be processed by the operators of these platforms. 6. Duration of Storage of Personal Data:

The duration of processing or storage of employee photos depends on the agreed processing purpose as well as the presence of consent.

7. Rights of Data Subjects:

You have the right to obtain information about the processing of your personal data and the detailed information listed in Art. 15 GDPR. If the relevant personal data is incorrect or incomplete, you can request the correction or completion of this data (Art. 16 GDPR). If one of the reasons listed in Art. 17 GDPR applies, you have the right to request the immediate deletion of your personal data. Under the conditions of Art. 18 GDPR, you can request the restriction of processing and according to Art. 20 GDPR the data portability.

Under the conditions of Art. 21 GDPR, you have the right to object to the processing of your personal data.

If you believe that the processing of your personal data violates the provisions of the GDPR, you can lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority, for example, with the State Commissioner for Data Protection and Freedom of Information of the Free Hanseatic City of Bremen, as the supervisory authority responsible for us (Art. 77 GDPR). Automated decision-making within the meaning of Art. 22 para. 1 GDPR does not take place.
